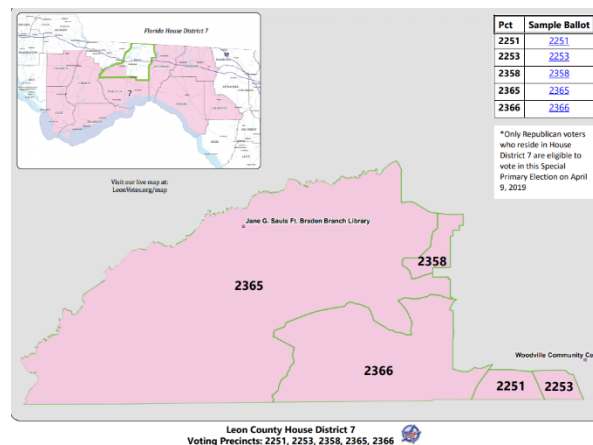
Election Day for the Republican House District 7 Special Primary

- Precinct 2366 – Crossway Baptist Church 405 Crossway Rd.

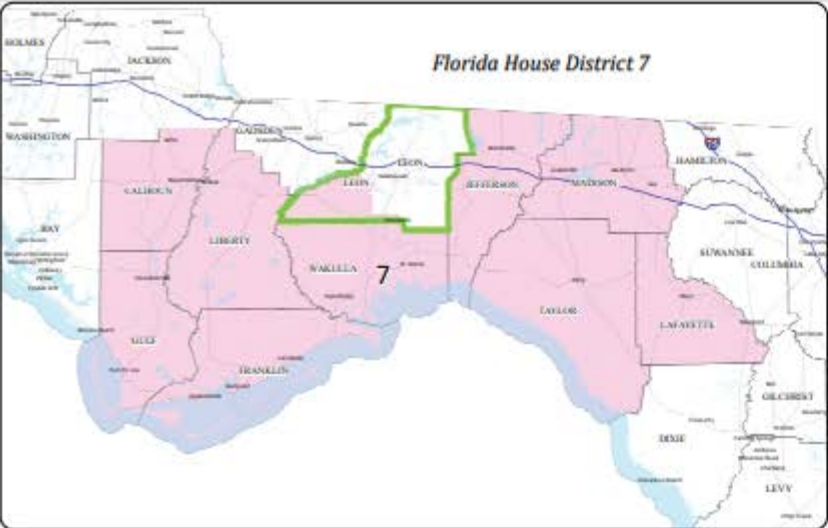

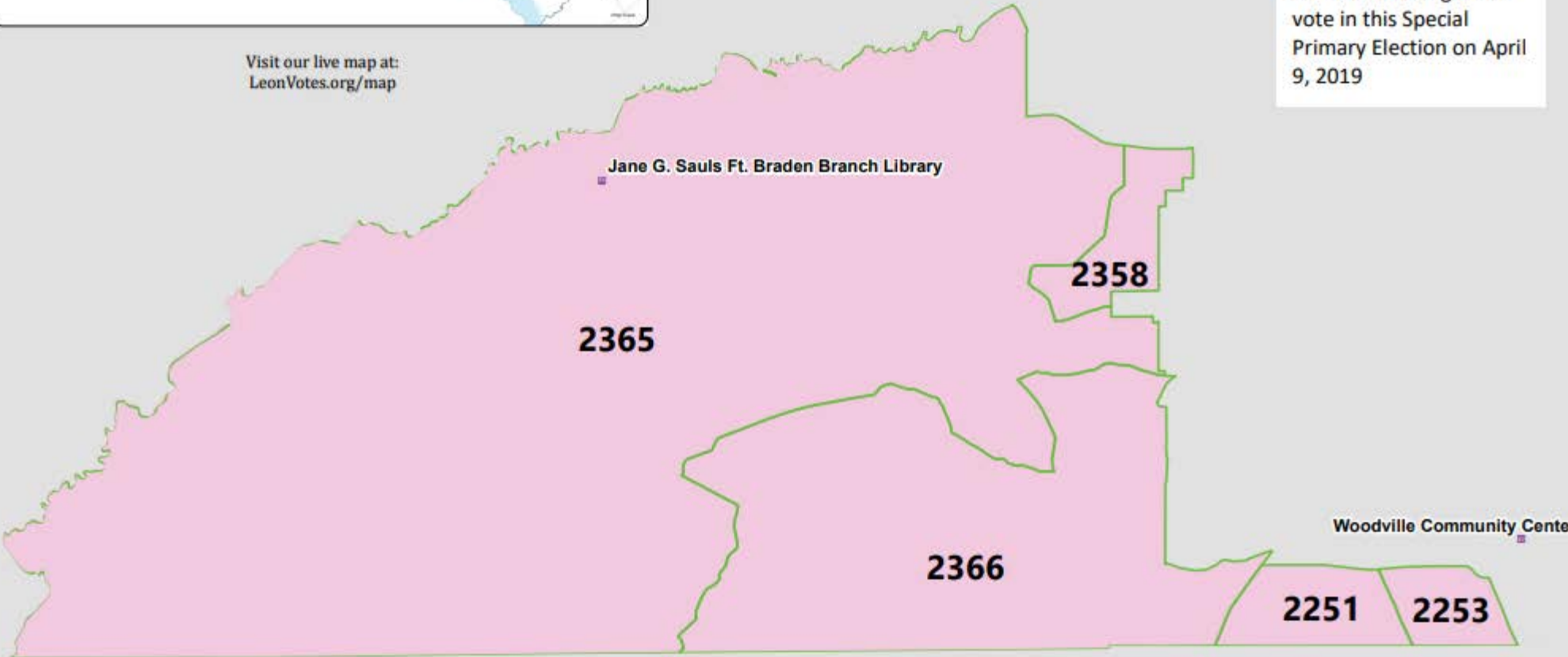


Florida House District 7
